The past 2 years has been exciting for complete street on the Northside. Asian Media Access has been involved with the Blue Line Coalition, Northside Greenway Coalition and the appointment on the Equity Advisory Committee with the Metropolitan Council. The Blue Line Coalition mission is to build community-based power to advance local and regional equity and community health by securing community benefits, changing policies and systems to support the creation of wealth and well-being of historic communities of color, immigrant/refugees, migrants, people living with disabilities and low-income communities along the Blue Line Corridor. They were able to secure a grant that will enable them to hire a part-time staff that will support the mission. On November 16, 2016 Maureen Ramirez, ED for the Northside Funders Group, introduced her agency as the Host Agency for the potential new hire.
